## Residents of 10 Milwaukee zip codes eligible for COVID-19 vaccine starting Monday

Yesterday, local leaders announced that residents ages 18 and older of 10 Milwaukee zip codes - 53204, 53205, 53206, 53209, 53215, 53216, 53218, 53223, 53224 and 53233 – will be eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine starting Monday, March 22. 2<sup>nd</sup> District **Alderman Cavalier Johnson**, whose district includes the 53216, 53218 and 53224 zip codes, is encouraging residents to take advantage of this expanded eligibility.

“I want to thank the city, county and state officials who collaborated to help make this expanded eligibility a reality. Providing vaccine access to areas that are traditionally underserved is an important step toward reducing health disparities,” said Alderman Johnson. “I’d urge all residents in my district who reside in one of these zip codes to schedule an appointment next week to receive the vaccine.”

The state also announced that those with certain health conditions will become eligible for a vaccine on Monday, one week earlier than initially expected. Among the conditions included are asthma, cancer, high blood pressure and obesity. The vaccine and its administration are free at the city and county sites and there is no insurance requirement.
