**Statement of Alderman Mark Chambers, Jr.**  
**December 12, 2022**

Postal carrier Aundre Cross was a friendly, likeable, dependable and hardworking public servant who was just doing his job when he was gunned down Friday (December 9, 2022) in a yard near N. 65<sup>th</sup> and W. Lancaster in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Aldermanic District.

My prayers are with his family members, neighbors, coworkers and friends. The murder has shaken the community and the close-knit group of USPS workers across the city who, like Mr. Cross, perform their duties quietly and diligently every day.

I am asking for the public's help in catching the person or persons responsible for the murder, and I encourage residents to view the attached images and info. Additionally, the United States Postal Inspection Service is offering a **reward of up to \$50,000** for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person who killed Mr. Cross.

Let's work together to bring justice to the family.

The incident occurred at approximately 4:38 PM on December 9, 2022.

The suspect vehicle, shown above, is described as a silver Audi Q5 SUV with tinted windows.

The suspect(s) should be considered armed and dangerous.
