Bronzeville Zoning Overlay Open House is TONIGHT

Alderwoman Milele A. Coggs, the Department of City Development, the Historic King Drive Business Improvement District 8, and community stakeholders are working to create a zoning overlay for the Bronzeville Cultural and Entertainment District, and thoughts and feedback from the public are being sought.

The goal of the new zoning overlay is to make sure future development supports the growth of Bronzeville as a cultural and entertainment destination that highlights African-American arts and culture. The overlay will add rules for land use and building design decisions for properties within the overlay boundaries.

An open house for residents to learn about the project is set for TONIGHT – **Wednesday, June 22 from 5 – 7 p.m.** with a short overview at 5:45 p.m. The open house will take place at **America’s Black Holocaust Museum, 401 W. North Ave.** This is an opportunity to learn more and provide feedback on recommendations for building design requirements in the overlay. Masks are required for attendees.
