Murder of Black transgender woman subject of City Hall news conference

Alderwoman JoCasta Zamarripa will hold a news conference TOMORROW – Thursday, June 30 -- at 1:30 p.m. at City Hall with the hopes of gaining information that may lead to finding the person(s) who killed Brazil Johnson, a young Black transgender woman who was found murdered on June 15 near W. Garfield and N. Teutonia. Also speaking at the press conference will be MPD Sergeant Guadalupe Velasquez.

"It is devastating that in light of Milwaukee's recent Pride celebrations, we are once again reminded of the harsh reality where transgender women of color suffer higher rates of violence than their straight, LGB, and white trans counterparts," Alderwoman Zamarripa said. "We can and must do better to protect our most vulnerable."
