# **Public safety technology partnership aims to make the community safer**

## **Statement of Alderwoman Chantia Lewis May 3, 2022**

This morning I had the privilege of joining Police Chief Jeffrey Norman, Havenwoods Business Improvement District Board Chair Steve Hentzen and Josh Thomas of Flock Safety to announce a new partnership aimed at making the Havenwoods community a safer place.

The Havenwoods Business Improvement District and Flock Safety will be partnering to bring automated license plate reading cameras to the 9<sup>th</sup> District to help combat reckless driving, among other crimes, and provide police with objective evidence and real-time alerts. I'm thrilled that our district will be able to utilize this technology which has helped reduce crime by up to 70% in other communities, and has proven successful elsewhere in our city.

This is a fantastic example of a public-private partnership that can help improve the quality of life in our community, and I want to thank all of those involved in this effort as we work collaboratively to make Milwaukee a safer place for all residents.

Lastly, I want to encourage other BIDs to look into creating this type of partnership so we can greatly expand the coverage area.
