Mayoral budget vetoes to be taken up at Common Council meeting on November 22

Today (Friday, November 11), Mayor Cavalier Johnson delivered a veto message for budget amendments adopted by the Common Council during its meeting on Friday, November 4.

“This is a process like any other. We did our part in adopting the City budget and the Mayor has now done his. We look forward to reviewing his vetoes and continuing to work in the best interests of all residents,” said **Common Council President José G. Pérez** and **Finance and Personnel Committee Chair Alderwoman Marina Dimitrijevic** in response to the Mayor’s vetoes.

The Common Council will take up the Mayor’s budget vetoes at its next meeting at 9 a.m. on Tuesday, November 22. The vote will either sustain or override the vetoes, with a two-thirds majority required to override. If the vetoes are overridden, the 2023 City budget will be adopted as amended by the Common Council on November 4th. If the vetoes are sustained, another vote will be held for passage of what the Mayor has proposed, or for a new amendment to replace the vetoed line-items.
