## Garden District ushers in the holiday season with multiple events this week

The 13<sup>th</sup> Aldermanic District – also known as the Garden District – will celebrate the holiday season with multiple events taking place this week. The annual district tree lighting and Winter Wonderland display will kick-off the festivities on Tuesday, November 29 at the intersection of 6<sup>th</sup> and Norwich, one block south of Howard.
