Today the Common Council approved file #230050 – a resolution approving the **HaRUNbee 5K Walk/Run** for Healthy Birth Outcomes as part of Bronzeville Week 2023. The 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Bronzeville Week will take place August 5-12, with the HaRUNbee 5K set to kick off the week of activities at 7:00 a.m. on **Saturday, August 5**.

The HaRUNbee 5K Walk/Run for Healthy Birth Outcomes, organized by the National Coalition for Healthy Black Families, **will take place in-person**. The popular event was designed to raise awareness and help prevent unhealthy birth outcomes across the region, and aims to promote wellness by encouraging families to stay healthy both mentally and physically.
