## **Ald. Taylor introduces communication file to discuss ICE facility relocation**

9<sup>th</sup> District Alderwoman Larresa Taylor has introduced a communication file to allow for a public and transparent discussion about the proposed relocation of the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) facility from 310 E. Knapp Street to 11925 W. Lake Park Drive in the 9<sup>th</sup> District.

“I recently stated my intention to make sure the community, particularly those in the 9<sup>th</sup> District, are fully aware of what is happening and when in regards to the possible relocation of an ICE facility to the 9<sup>th</sup> District. Opening this communication file is part of that promise so my colleagues and I can ensure we are open with the public and all working with the same information,” said Alderwoman Taylor. “This situation remains fluid, but as I know more, so too will my constituents. Their voices deserve to be heard on this issue that effects our district and city.”

The communication file will be heard at a future meeting of the Common Council’s Steering and Rules Committee. Once scheduled, further communications will be issued on how to watch or participate in the meeting.
