## **Saturday's final public info session on Midtown Center development will be fully virtual**

Alderman Mark Chambers, Jr. invites residents to take part in TOMORROW'S (Saturday, June 27) fully virtual public informational meeting about the proposed development at Midtown Center (at the former Walmart at **5825 W. Hope Ave.**) that, if approved, would house a Milwaukee Public Library branch, computing facility, storage units, and housing.
