Council officially designates HaRUNbee 5K Walk/Run for Healthy Birth Outcomes as part of Bronzeville Week

Today (Tuesday, July 14), the Common Council adopted **file #260430** – a resolution approving the **HaRUNbee 5K Walk/Run for Healthy Birth Outcomes** as part of Bronzeville Week 2026. This year will be the 11th annual HaRUNbee 5K Walk/Run, taking place during the 16th Annual Bronzeville Week, running from August 1-8, with the HaRUNbee 5K kicking off the week of activities on **Saturday, August 1**.

The HaRUNbee 5K Walk/Run for Healthy Birth Outcomes was designed to raise awareness and to prevent unhealthy birth outcomes across the nation. Organized by the National Coalition for Healthy Black Families (NCHBF), the HaRUNbee Walk/Run promotes wellness by encouraging families to stay healthy and fit, both mentally and physically.
