### **Compost Workshop and Plant Sale Return to the Garden District Saturday**

Alderman Scott Spiker invites the public to attend Saturday's interactive composting workshop presented by Keep Greater Milwaukee Beautiful, in partnership with the city's Department of Public Works. The workshop will occur at the Garden District Community Garden Gazebo, located at 6<sup>th</sup> and Norwich (one block south of Howard). The workshop will move indoors in the event of rain, and is free to attend.

"Whether you are new to home composting or need a refresher, this workshop is designed to teach all ages what composting is, why it's important, and how to compost in your backyard," Alderman Spiker said. The workshop will begin at 11 a.m. and will be approximately 45 minutes long, including a presentation, hands-on learning, and a Q&A session.

The Garden District Neighborhood Association will also host a plant sale during Saturday's event, featuring a variety of vegetables and flowers. Additionally, anyone who purchased a compost bin during the 15<sup>th</sup> annual city compost bin sale can pick up their bin on Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Milwaukee DPW Sanitation Building, 4031 S. 6<sup>th</sup> St.
