Ald. Davis To Take Part In 6 P.M. Dedication Of New Milwaukee Achiever Literacy Services Center

Ald. Joe Davis, Sr. will take part in a special ribbon-cutting ceremony at **6 p.m.** marking the newly relocated northwest side **Milwaukee Achiever Literacy Services** learning center at 5566 N. 69th St. (corner of N. 69th and W. Silver Spring Dr.). **News media coverage of the event is invited.**

Ald. Davis, chair of the Common Council's Community and Economic Development Committee, said the new location (in the former rectory of St. Philip Neri Parish) allows MALS to meet the increased demand for its adult literacy and workforce development services. "I'm honored to be helping Milwaukee Achiever dedicate this wonderful new northwest side learning center – a place where community members will be able to sharpen their skills and enrich their lives," he said.

The new location provides space MALS needs to offer one-on-one and small group tutoring to more than 200 adult learners per month. Programs offered at the new center include adult basic education, English as a second language (ESL), pre-GED, GED/HSED, basic/intermediate computer skills, and workforce development through MALS' JobLink program.

Milwaukee Achiever also has a south side neighborhood learning center at 1512 W. Pierce St.
