October 31, 2007

This morning my home in the 800 block of N. 29th St. was burglarized. The intruder or intruders kicked in my back door and took several items, including a laptop computer and some electronics items, including a DVD player and a television. They rifled through several drawers and also opened a few closets.

Milwaukee police have been talking with me, asking questions, and have been closely examining my home inside and out. They will continue to investigate and I'm grateful for their assistance.

Although I do feel angry about what happened, I'm thankful I wasn't home and most of the items that were taken can be replaced. I've lived in the Historic Concordia Neighborhood for 10 years, and nothing like this has ever happened to me. My commitment to improving public safety throughout the City of Milwaukee remains unchanged, and I will continue doing all I can to enhance and improve my neighborhood.
