Unity Caucus Members To Canvass Near Quadruple Homicide Location Today

Several members of the Unity Caucus will go door-to-door today to distribute information in the Metcalfe Park neighborhood where four people were shot to death on July 4, according to **Ald. Willie C. Wade**, chair of the Unity Caucus.

At 2 p.m. today Unity Caucus members – elected officials who represent inner-city Milwaukee districts on all levels of government – will start knocking on doors to distribute and share information about how residents can anonymously provide information to law enforcement agencies about criminal activity. “We will be spreading the word that there are several methods residents can use to remain completely anonymous – with no one asking you to ever give your name or address – and help bring dangerous criminals to justice,” said Ald. Wade, noting also the \$10,000 reward in the July 4 case announced Tuesday by MillerCoors.

“That (\$10,000) is a generous reward, and we hope it spurs someone to pick up the phone and give the police the tip that brings the killer or killers to justice,” he said.
