Three Reasons to Vote Absentee:

- ✓ **1** It's free! Your ballot is mailed to you with a postage-paid return envelope.
- ✓ **2** It's safe. Keeps you safe from the Coronavirus threat.
- ✓ **3** No standing in line. Your ballot is sent and returned through the mail.

What Happens After You Request an Absentee Ballot?

Your ballot will arrive about 1 week after your request. You can track it on MyVote.wi.gov.

If you have already completed an absentee request, your ballot will arrive shortly. You can confirm it MyVote.wi.gov.
