New Midtown Center Restaurant Credited for Hiring Local Residents, Contractors

Harold's Chicken Shack #55 restaurant at **4138 N. 56th St.** will host a grand opening ceremony on **Wednesday, July 15, 2009 at 11:00 a.m.** The restaurant, according to **Alderman Joe Davis, Sr.**, has stepped up and hired low-income city residents to work all shifts, and it hired local contractors to complete the \$500,000 build-out at its location.
