Who needs a Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License?

Anyone operating a public passenger vehicle in the city of Milwaukee (including a human service vehicle licensed or otherwise regulated by the State of Wisconsin).

PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLE means a vehicle which is used for the transportation of passengers by hire, including limousines, horse and surrey livery, pedicabs, taxicabs, shuttles, motorcycles used for tours, and human service vehicles operating on the streets of the city of Milwaukee.

Exemption

Drivers of network transportation companies

Eligibility

Must be 18 years of age or older
 Must hold a valid State of Wisconsin Motor Vehicle Driver's License (excluding an Occupational License)

License Period

License expires 2 years from date of issuance.
 License must be issued within 1 year of approval, or a waiver from the Public Works Committee is needed.

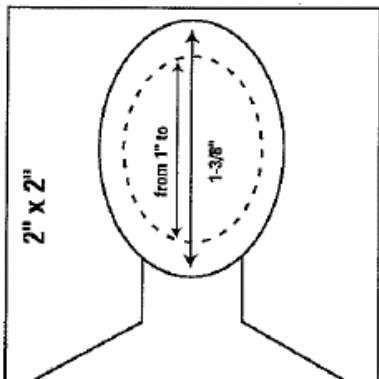
Application Requirements

- \$75 Fee
- Individual Application (ccl-iapp)
- Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License Supplemental Application (ccl-drn1)
- Passport size photograph

Photograph

One 2 x 2 inch (from the bottom of the chin to the top of the head, including hair) clear colored full face photograph with the following requirements:

- Taken in front of a plain white or off-white background; within the last 6 months to reflect your current appearance.



Public Passenger Vehicle License

No vehicle owner or lessee shall operate their vehicle, or allow their vehicle to be operated, as a public passenger vehicle for hire upon the streets of the city without the vehicle owner or lessee first obtaining for the vehicle a Public Passenger Vehicle Permit.

Course Completion

Completion of a defensive driving course or map test are only required if directed by the Common Council as a condition of granting, renewal, or suspension of a driver's license application.

Drivers wishing to obtain a license for operating Class "H" Human Service Vehicles, must complete a Passenger Assistance Techniques Training course, and upon completion, submit the certificate to our office prior to issuance of the license. The course must have been taken within 3 years prior to the license application date. See list of approved trainers on page 2.

Issuance of License

Licenses may be issued upon completion of all application requirements unless the Milwaukee Police Department objects to the issuance of the license based on its findings.

In that case, the applicant will be scheduled for a hearing before the Public Works Committee. The Public Works Committee will make a recommendation to the Common Council on whether or not to grant the license.

Disqualification

If your application is denied based on items in your police report, you cannot reapply for a new permit until after 12 months from the denied date.
