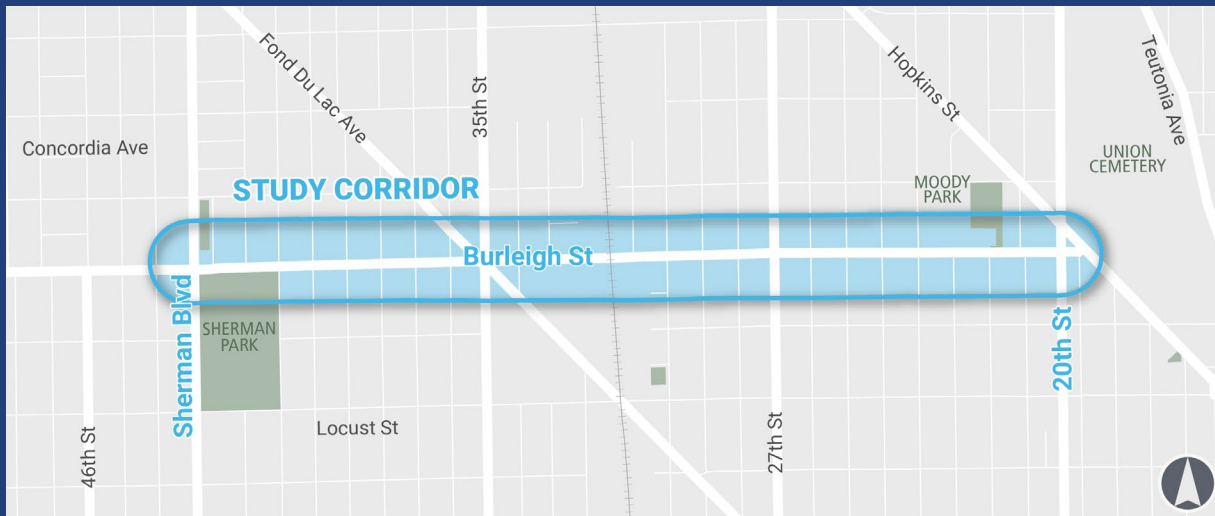


OVERVIEW

The City of Milwaukee has kicked off a Safe Routes to Transit project along Burleigh Street, from Sherman Boulevard to 20th Street. This project will focus on making the street safer, more comfortable, and more accessible for people walking and taking the bus.



Burleigh Street is home to many residents, shops, community services, parks, and schools. Burleigh Street is also a major transit corridor with high frequency Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) Routes. However, the corridor has some of the highest rates of severe and fatal crashes involving pedestrians.

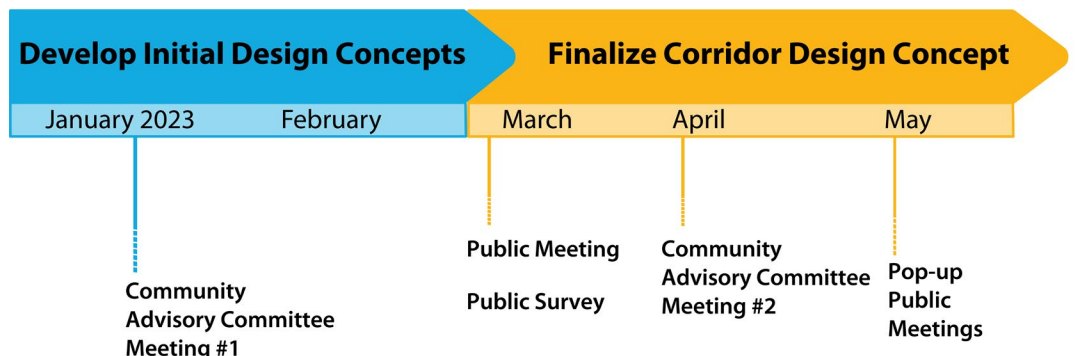
The project will improve safety through street improvements like:

- high-visibility crosswalks
- updated ADA ramps
- curb extensions
- raised crosswalks
- bus bulbs
- bus stop improvements
