Mayor Johnson to sign legislation advancing Maxon Industries expansion on Milwaukee's north side

\$2.8 million investment to create new jobs in Milwaukee

MILWAUKEE – Milwaukee Mayor Cavalier Johnson will hold a ceremonial signing celebrating the approval of legislation supporting the expansion of the Milwaukee-based manufacturing company, Maxon Industries, Inc., on Milwaukee's north side.

The Milwaukee Common Council approved the land sale on June 2, paving the way for Maxon Industries to purchase 1.6 acres of city-owned land at 6600 N. Teutonia Ave., adjacent to its headquarters at 3204 W. Mill Road. The expansion project is expected to bring approximately \$2.8 million in new investment and create 25 new jobs in Milwaukee.
