

HOW OUR BUDGET PROCESS WORKS

Each year the Mayor, Common Council and City of Milwaukee staff work together to develop an annual balanced budget.

This involves making decisions on how to use the limited revenues the City of Milwaukee receives to provide high quality services for city residents.

A FIVE STEP PROCESS

PREPARE

February to May

City departments prepare budget requests describing funding they need to operate and provide high quality services

DRAFT

June to September

Mayor discusses requests with City departments and seeks input from residents

PUBLIC HEARING:
Tuesday, August 17
5:30 p.m.

PROPOSE

Late September

Based on input from residents, City departments, and the Common Council, the Mayor presents Proposed Budget to the Common Council

REVIEW

October

Finance & Personnel Committee Hearings on the 2022 Proposed Budget

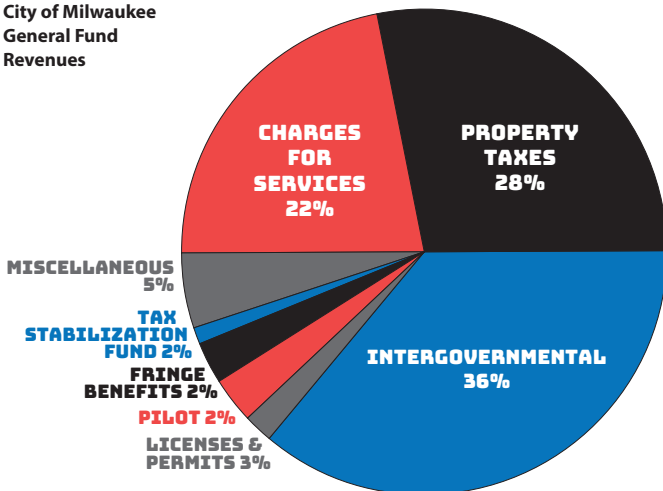

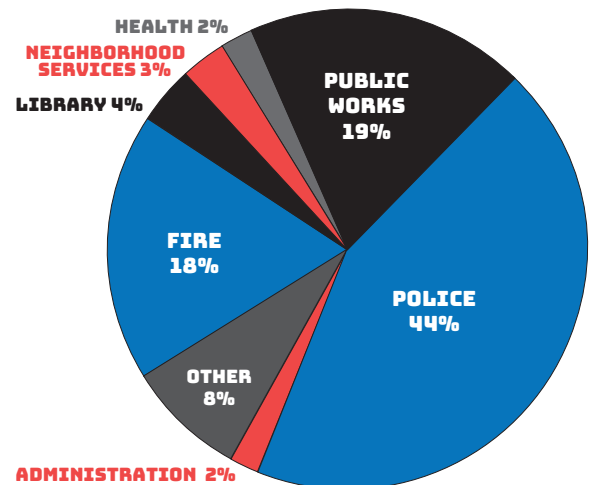
WHERE THE MONEY COMES FROM:
