Department of Public Works Services For the Independence Day Holiday

City of Milwaukee government offices will be closed on Wednesday, July 4, 2018 in celebration of the Independence Day holiday. However, some Department of Public Works (DPW) services will be available for limited hours of operation and certain parking restrictions will be lifted.

Garbage, Recycling, and Drop-Off Centers:

- There will be no garbage and recycling pick-up on Wednesday, July 4
- Drop-Off Centers will be closed on Wednesday, July 4

Parking Enforcement:

- **No parking meter or hourly enforcement** on Wednesday, July 4
- **No overnight parking enforcement** Tuesday night into Wednesday morning (July 4 from 2:00 to 6:00 a.m.), and Wednesday night into Thursday morning (July 5 from 2:00 to 6:00 a.m.)
- **Overnight parking enforcement resumes** on Thursday night into Friday morning (July 6 from 2:00 to 6:00 a.m.)

- **OPEN:** Wednesday, July 4 – 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon
