For-profit and non-profit organizations, including taverns and churches, are charged equipment fees for block parties, special events and banner/flag displays.

All Special Event Permit Applications are reviewed by the Milwaukee Police Department. MPD will classify each event and determine if their assistance is required based on the size, location, and nature of the event. Permittee will be charged for MPD services according to the number of police service hours required.

By ordinance, permits issued for Class A, B and C events must furnish an original certificate of insurance which provides minimum combined single limits for bodily injury and property damage of \$1,000,000, naming the City of Milwaukee as additional insured.
