North 30th Street Corridor Wet Weather Relief- East: Contract 2



The project is managed by the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) in conjunction with the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works (DPW).

Start Date: August 15, 2016 – Anticipated Completion: Fall 2017

Project Overview

The project consists of installation of a concrete box storm sewer from the intersection of North 27th Street and West Hope Avenue, north to W. Roosevelt Drive, and west to North 30th Street. From there, the box storm sewer extends to two storm water retention basins: the east storm water retention basin and the north storm water retention basin. The basins will include landscaping, pathways and plazas, and site lighting. The project will also include new concrete curbs and gutters and new concrete pavement on North 27th Street, West Roosevelt Drive and North 30th Street.

Project Timeline

The project will be accomplished in eight phases starting on August 15, 2016 with an anticipated completion date of Fall 2017. Updates on the actual start dates of each phase will be sent on a regular basis.

- **Phase 1** - Construction of storm water retention basins. This phase is currently under way with completion scheduled for November 2016
- **Phase 2** - Utility relocations. The contractor will relocate several existing water and sanitary sewer lines to allow for installation of the box storm sewer. Periodic 2-3 day partial road closures will occur in September 2016. Temporary detours may be required during this phase.

Bus Routes

The #27 Street bus route – Service on North 27th Street will be maintained throughout the project. Two bus stops, located at North 27th Street/West Roosevelt Drive and North 27th Street/West Hope Avenue, will be temporarily relocated during construction of the box storm sewer on North 27th Street.

Parking, Pedestrian and Driveway Access

On-street parking will not be available during construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained to abutting properties and businesses during construction with the least amount of inconvenience. MMSD staff and the contractor will work to minimize the amount of time any driveway access is restricted, and will notify the property owner 48 hours in advance of any driveway work.

Working Hours

Work is allowed from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, and 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Saturdays. The contractor cannot work outside these hours without prior approval from the MMSD.



Communications

The Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District and City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works will have staff overseeing the various portions of the work:

Resident Engineer: Will address concerns with the construction contractor.

Resident Inspector: Will be on-site fulltime to oversee the contractor's work and ensure that the concerns of the public are being addressed.

City of Milwaukee Support for Business Liaison (SBL): Will provide information about the construction, and share timelines and procedures via construction updates with businesses and other key organizations. The SBL also coordinates with the Resident Engineer and the Resident Inspector to resolve concerns from businesses and residents.
