



North 92nd Street West Capitol Drive to West Hampton Avenue


Anticipated Start Date: May 22, 2017

Anticipated Completion Date: November 22, 2017

The project is funded and managed by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation in conjunction with the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works.

Project Overview:

The paving project consists of removing and replacing the concrete pavement, curbs, gutters, and driveway approaches. Sidewalks will be replaced as necessary. The northbound and southbound roadways will be widened by at least one foot to improve traffic circulation, and to provide bike lane accommodations for the entire length of the project. North 92nd Street from West Capitol Drive to West Hampton Avenue will be replaced one half of the roadway at a time, with a single lane of traffic in each direction.



Project Timeline:

The project will be accomplished in two phases:

- **Phase 1** - May 22 through approximately August 21: Two-way traffic will be maintained in the existing southbound lanes, one lane in each direction, while reconstruction is occurring in the northbound lanes.
- **Phase 2** - Approximately August 21 through November 22: Reconstruction moves to the northbound lanes, while two-way traffic will be maintained in the southbound lanes.

In order to provide access to traffic generators on West Congress Street, four-way traffic access will continue at the intersection of North 92nd Street and West Congress Street.

Parking, Pedestrian, and Driveway Access:

On-street parking will not be available during construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained to abutting properties and businesses during construction with the least amount of inconvenience. City staff and the contractor will work to minimize the amount of time any driveway access is restricted, and will notify the property owner 48 hours in advance of any driveway work.

Working Hours:

Work is allowed from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., Monday through Friday. The contractor cannot work on weekends without prior approval from the Department of Public Works.

Communication and Contact Information

The City of Milwaukee will have staff overseeing various portions of the work:

Construction Management Engineer: Will address contractor concerns.

Project Inspector: Will be on-site full time to oversee the contractor's work and ensure that the concerns of the public and businesses are addressed.

Support for Business Liaison (SBL): Will provide information about the construction project, share timelines and procedures via construction updates with businesses and key organizations. The SLB also coordinates with Construction Management Engineer and Project Inspectors to resolve concerns from businesses and residents.

Bus Route Detour Information:

Route # 12 will continue west on Hampton Avenue and will u-turn and layover west of 92nd Street. Route #23 will detour in both directions using Capitol Drive between 84th Street and 92nd Street. Route # 57 will continue north on 92nd Street and will u-turn north of Hampton Avenue (near Fairmount Street).
