

CONSTRUCTION FORECAST



The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), in partnership with the City of Milwaukee, is reconstructing WIS 32 (North Lake Drive) between East Newberry Boulevard and East Edgewood Avenue. The following work is scheduled to take place between East Kenwood Boulevard and East Edgewood Avenue over the next several weeks.

Week of November 11, 2024:

Crews are scheduled to complete driveway approaches and sidewalk repairs on the east side of N. Lake Drive.

- East side driveways are scheduled to reopen Thursday, November 14.

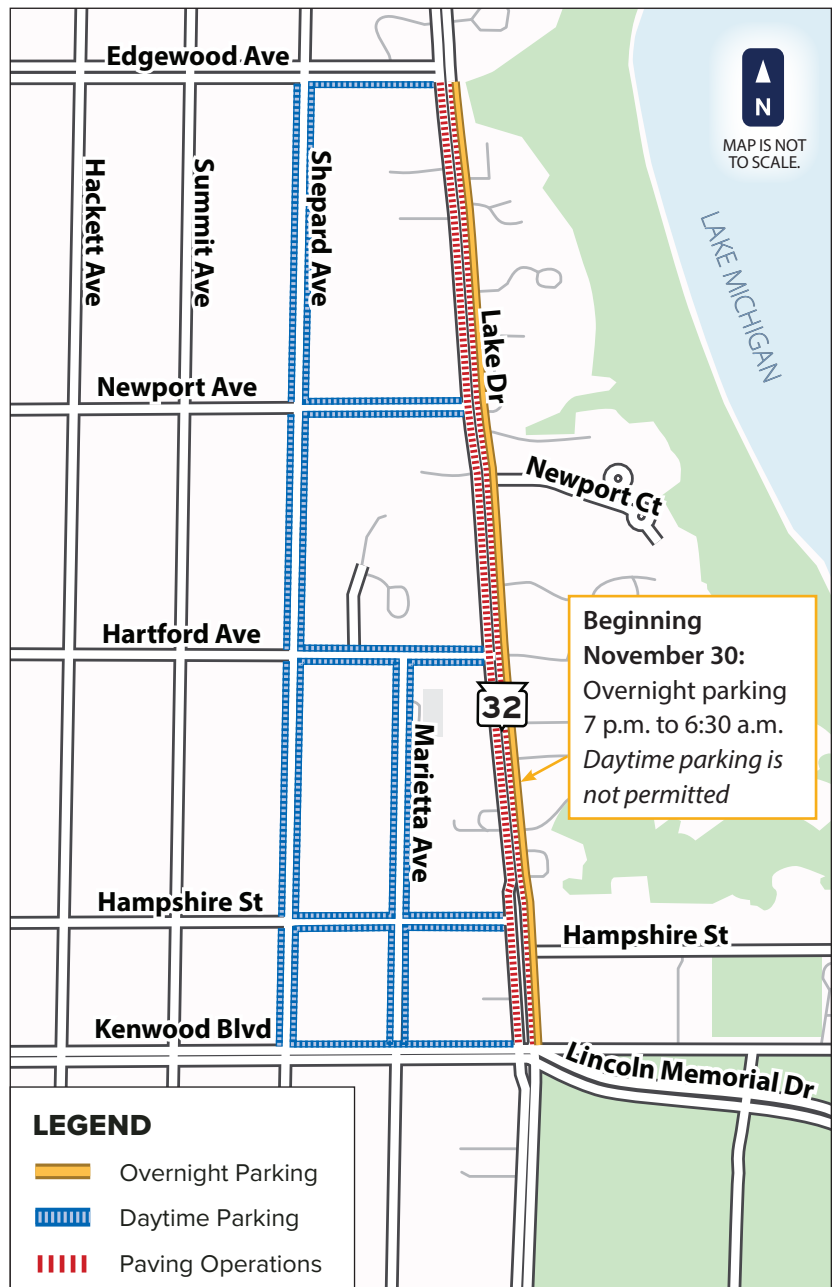
Driveway approach paving on the west side of N. Lake Drive is scheduled to begin.

- Residents on the west side of N. Lake Drive must remove vehicles they want to remain accessible from their driveways by 6:30 a.m., Wednesday, November 13.

Sidewalk repairs on the west side of N. Lake Drive are scheduled to begin.

- This work will cause temporary closure of the sidewalk on the west side of N. Lake Drive.
- Pedestrians are encouraged to use the sidewalk on the east side of N. Lake Drive.

Crews will be milling and paving E. Hampshire Street, E. Hartford Avenue and E. Newport Avenue at N. Lake Drive to create a smooth transition between new pavement and existing pavement.



All work is weather dependent and subject to change.

Week of November 18, 2024:

Crews are scheduled to continue paving driveway approaches on the west side of N. Lake Drive.

- Residents may resume using their driveways after the concrete cures and crews have removed the cones blocking their driveway.

Sidewalk repairs and paving are scheduled to continue on the west side of N. Lake Drive.

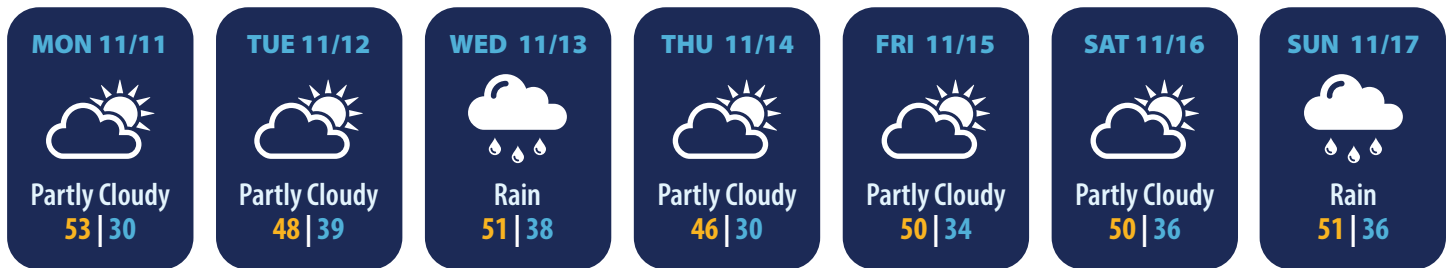
- This work will cause temporary closure of the sidewalk on the west side of N. Lake Drive.
- Pedestrians are encouraged to use the sidewalk on the east side of N. Lake Drive.

Landscape restoration is scheduled to begin on the east side of N. Lake Drive.

North Lake Drive Residents:

- Starting Wednesday, November 13, overnight parking on the east side of N. Lake Drive is allowed from 7 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. Daytime parking in the work zone is not permitted.
- Daytime parking time limits between E. Kenwood Boulevard and E. Edgewood Avenue have been lifted through November 30, 2024. *(See map on page 1 for more details)*
- Garbage and recycling services for N. Lake Drive residents will be maintained.
- A single southbound lane of N. Lake Drive will be maintained for residential access.
