



# E/W Howard Avenue - Street Reconstruction

## PROJECT COMPLETION NOTICE

### E/W Howard Avenue Reconstruction Project is complete!

The City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works (DPW) has completed the reconstruction of E/W Howard Avenue from S. 6th Street to S. Clement Avenue.

The following work was completed as part of the project:

- Existing pavement was removed and replaced with new 9-inch concrete pavement, curb and gutter, driveway approaches and sidewalk
- Street lighting, traffic signals and drainage structures were upgraded throughout the corridor
- Pedestrian curb ramps were rebuilt to be ADA compliant
- Bike lanes were added in both directions throughout the corridor, including raised, separated bike lanes between S. Howell and S. Clement avenues
- Curb extensions were installed throughout the corridor to shorten crossing distances, increase visibility and reduce parking too close to intersections

In recent weeks, tree planting and landscaping took place throughout the corridor.

Please note there is a punch list of final items that the contractor is working through from the City of Milwaukee. These items will be addressed as soon as possible.

### **CURBSIDE SANITATION SERVICES WITH RAISED, SEPARATED BIKE LANE**

Residents should place trash and recycling carts on the street side of the sidewalk. Brush and bulky items should also be placed on the street side of the sidewalk. No carts or items should be placed on the raised, separated bike lane.
