

NOTICE TO ALL CONTRACTORS WORKING ON DPW PROJECTS

April 7, 2020

During the current Covid-19 crisis, the City of Milwaukee wants to thank you for adhering to the following reminder regarding social distancing: All permitted work in the Public Way related to Essential Infrastructure and Essential Businesses and Operations will be required to follow the State of Wisconsin "Safer at Home" order and the City of Milwaukee "Stay-at-Home" Requirements. All entities shall meet Social Distancing Requirements between all individuals on the premises to the extent possible. If work within the right of way is found non-compliant with the State and City orders, the City will have the right to stop work and revoke any permit effective immediately.

With regard to the revised dates of the Democratic National Convention, any current contract special provisions you hold with the City of Milwaukee are hereby amended by the Commissioner of Public Works to read: "No construction activity shall be allowed during the National Democratic Convention (DNC) from August 15, 2020 through August 23, 2020 on this contract. The contractor shall leave all work zones clean, safely barricaded and accessible per the direction of the construction engineer, inclusive of required open lanes of traffic."
