



North Teutonia Avenue West Capitol Drive to West Ruby Avenue

Project Start Date - Early July 2015 weather permitting and Project Completion Date: November 2015

Project Overview

The project is being funded by the City of Milwaukee and the Wisconsin Department of Transportation. The existing pavement surface is in poor condition and has been heavily patched over the years. The project will consist of removing the existing roadway and replacing it with concrete pavement while widening the roadway. All curb, gutter and driveway approaches will be replaced. Sidewalks will be replaced as necessary due to grade and condition.

Traffic Control

In order to allow traffic to continue to travel on Teutonia during construction, the paving project will be done in two stages. **During Stage 1:** two-way traffic will be maintained in the existing southbound lanes. **During Stage 2:** two-way traffic will be switched over to use the newly-constructed northbound lanes.

Parking, Pedestrian and Driveway Access

On-street parking will not be available during construction. Provisions will be made to ensure that pedestrian access will be maintained to abutting properties and businesses during construction with the least amount of inconvenience. Department of Public Works (DPW) staff and the contractor will work to minimize the time any driveway access is restricted, and will notify the owner 48 hours in advance.

Working Hours

With the exception of holidays, no daily restrictions exist. Work is allowed from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. No work on weekends, without prior approval.

Bus Route Detour (Please refer to the attached bus route maps.)

The **#12 Teutonia – Hampton bus** will continue to operate on North Teutonia Avenue in the south bound two-way traffic lanes during Stage 1, and in the northbound two-way traffic lanes during Stage 2.

The **#19 Atkinson Avenue bus** will be detoured to avoid the North Teutonia Avenue and West Atkinson Avenue intersection reconstruction.





Communication & Contact Information

A public information meeting was held April 8, 2014 at the Atkinson Library to provide information regarding the construction project. Residents and businesses located in the project area were invited.

The City of Milwaukee Construction Supervisor will regularly visit the construction project to address contractor concerns, monitor changes in conditions, and provide answers and solutions. The Project Inspectors will be on the site to oversee the contractor's work and ensure that the concerns of the public and businesses are being addressed. The Support for Business Liaison works closely with the community to articulate neighborhood concerns to the Department of Public Works. The prime contractor selected for the construction project is LaLonde Contractors Inc.
