North Teutonia Avenue – West Capitol Drive to West Ruby Avenue Paving Construction Update

Phase 1 - North Teutonia Avenue from West Capitol Drive to West Roosevelt Drive:

- The existing pavement was removed and replaced on both sides of the street
- The street was widened to include bicycle lanes in each direction
- New curb and gutters and driveway approaches were installed
- Colored-stamped sidewalks were included as part of the project.

Two-way traffic including the #12 bus line has resumed on North Teutonia Avenue. Top soil, sod and pavement markings should be completed by early December, weather permitting. Once this work is completed, the #19 bus line on West Atkinson Avenue will resume its usual route.



Phase 2 - North Teutonia Avenue from West Roosevelt Drive to West Ruby Avenue:

Construction will start in April 2016 and will include:

- Complete removal and replacement of the pavement, curb and gutters, and driveway approaches
- New traffic signals built on the concrete bases installed this year.
