Project update!

The resurfacing of MLK, Dr. is scheduled to be completed in early December, winter weather permitting! The project timeline has been extended due to the additional curb and gutter being removed and replaced. With the improved curb and gutter, MLK will look better, be safer, and meet the Wisconsin DOT specifications.

What's left to be done?

- curb and gutter work
- manholes in the middle lanes will be adjusted
- surface paving and pavement markings
- remaining handicap ramps will be poured.

Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, from McKinley Ave. to Burleigh St. was resurfaced this fall. A major goal was to keep traffic moving while making an investment in the local infrastructure.
