SOUTHBOUND LANE CLOSURE

North 27th Street–West Highland Boulevard to West Lisbon Avenue

Stage 1 of the North 27th Street construction project from West Highland Boulevard to West Lisbon Avenue began in July 2016. The project consists of resurfacing the roadway with asphalt pavement, and replacing the sidewalks, curbs, gutters and driveway approaches as necessary. During the project, one lane of traffic has been maintained for both northbound and southbound travel.



Beginning Thursday, September 22nd, the southbound lane will be closed to through traffic, from West Highland Boulevard to West Lisbon Avenue.

The southbound closure will last for approximately 6 weeks. The closure will help to get the project back on schedule, as it was delayed due to design grade changes and two large rain events.

The northbound traffic lane on North 27th Street will remain open.



The closure also will allow Stage 2 work on the City Underground Conduit (CUC) to begin during Stage 1. Concrete base patching in the southbound lanes scheduled for Stage 2 can be completed as well during Stage 1 with the closure.

Southbound Bus Detour:

The #27 and Purple Line buses will travel west on West Brown Street to North 35th Street, proceed south on North 35th Street to West Highland Boulevard, then east on West Highland Boulevard to North 27th Street. Northbound buses will remain on North 27th Street throughout the project.
