



South 5th Street from West Virginia Street to West Scott Street

Anticipated start and completion date: July 5, 2016 / October 2016

The South 5th Street construction project is funded by the City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works and the Department of City Development.

Construction Project Overview

The project will consist of removing the road pavement and widening the sidewalks. The existing sidewalks are 8.5 feet wide and will be widened to 17.5 feet, resulting in the narrowing of the roadway. The roadway will consist of a driving lane and a parking lane in each direction. Angle parking will be converted to parallel parking. Driveways will be reconstructed to match the dimensions of the reconstructed sidewalks. Catch basins, pipes and manholes also will be installed as part of the paving project.

Traffic

Stage 1: Work will begin on the east side of the street with one-way traffic southbound and parking available on the west side of the street. The construction area will be closed from West Virginia to West Scott streets.

Stage 2: Work moves to the west side of the street with one-way traffic northbound and **no parking availability on the street.**

Cross traffic at intersections will be maintained as long as possible during construction.

Parking, Pedestrian and Driveway Access

On-street parking will not be available during the Stage 2 of the construction. Pedestrian and driveway access will be maintained for abutting properties and businesses during construction with the least amount of inconvenience. City staff and the contractor will work to minimize the amount of time any driveway access is restricted. Once the pavement has been removed, temporary gravel ramps can be installed for access to parking lots when roadwork is not occurring in those blocks.


Businesses can contact the Lead Project Inspector to help coordinate deliveries for those who do not have alley access during the project.

Two parking areas have been secured for use during the construction project. The Bradley Technical High School parking lot, South 4th Street and West Bruce Street, will be available 7:00 a.m. to 2:00 a.m., and the United Community Center parking lot, South 6th Street and West Washington Street, will be available after 6:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. Signage will be posted to alert the public of parking availability.

Communication and Contact Information:

- Construction Supervisor: Will address contractor concerns
- Lead Project Inspector: Will be on site full time to oversee the contractor's work and ensure that the concerns of the public and businesses are being addressed.
- Support for Business Liaison (SBL): Will provide information about the construction project, and share timelines and procedures via construction updates with businesses and other key organizations. The SBL also coordinates with the Construction Supervisor and Lead Project Inspector.

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
