South 13th Street from W. Cleveland Avenue to W. Windlake Avenue

project OVERVIEW

The City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works (DPW) in conjunction with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is in the midst of major improvements to South 13th Street. The work on this project involves reconstructing 0.6 miles of S. 13th Street from W. Cleveland Avenue to W. Windlake Avenue. Currently, this project is in the middle of stage 1 and this phase is scheduled to be complete by mid-August. During this phase, street parking will not be allowed on S. 13th Street from W. Cleveland Avenue to W. Windlake Avenue.



project SCHEDULE

Stage 1: June 7 to August 2010

- Construct the western half of the road from W. Cleveland Avenue to W. Windlake Avenue.
- 13th Street closed to southbound traffic.
- One northbound traffic lane will be open to through traffic on 13th Street.

Stage 2: August to early November 2010

- Construct the eastern half of the road from W. Cleveland Avenue to W. Windlake Avenue.
- One traffic lane open in each direction on the newly constructed southbound lanes of S. 13th Street.

Completion: Early November 2010

project TEAM
