Please be advised that the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners will meet at 8:30 a.m. on May 10, 2023, and May 11, 2023, for the purpose of conducting a Trial regarding the citizen complaint of Tocco Harris; FPC Citizen Complaint No.: 2022-0088. The hearing will be held on May 10, 2023, and May 11, 2023, before Dennis P. Moroney, the designated Hearing Examiner and a panel of three Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, WI 53202.

The Board may receive a motion to conduct a closed session pursuant to Section 19.85 (1)(a) and (c) Wis. Stats., for the purpose of conducting deliberations regarding these matters. Additionally, to deliberate concerning a case which was the subject of any judicial or quasi-judicial trial or hearing before that governmental body; and pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(f) Wis. Stats. to consider financial, medical, social or personal histories or disciplinary data of specific persons, preliminary consideration of specific personnel problems or the investigation of charges against specific persons which, if discussed in public, would be likely to have a substantial adverse effect upon the reputation of any person referred to in such histories or data, or involved in such problems or investigation.

Upon conclusion of the aforesaid closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session to announce its decision. Should that decision require additional testimony, such testimony will be received in open session. Deliberations thereafter may be conducted in closed session upon motion pursuant to Section 19.85 (1)(a) and (c) Wis. Stats., after which the Board will reconvene in open session and announce its final decision.

Upon reasonable notice, efforts will be made to accommodate the needs of persons with disabilities through sign language interpreters or auxiliary aids.
