The hearing will be held on June 21, 2022 and June 22, 2022, before a designated Hearing Examiner and a panel of three Board of Fire and Police Commissioners, in Room 301-A, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street.

The Board may receive a motion to conduct a closed session pursuant to Section 19.85 (1)(a) and (c) Wis. Stats., for the purpose of conducting deliberations regarding these matters. Upon conclusion of the aforesaid closed session, the Board will reconvene in open session to announce its decision. Should that decision require additional testimony, such testimony will be received in open session. Deliberations thereafter may be conducted in closed session upon motion pursuant to Section 19.85 (1)(a) and (c) Wis. Stats., after which the Board will reconvene in open session and announce its final decision.
