To the Parties of *Charles Collins, et al. v. City of Milwaukee, et al.*:

This letter serves as notice that the Crime and Justice Institute (CJI) is resubmitting with one revision our Six-Month Report on Non-Compliant Items from March 23, 2021. CJI became aware of an incongruence in statements from our Second Annual Report and our Six-Month Report regarding the missing data assessment of the Use of Force (UOF) Justification field for TraCS data.

The Settlement Agreement paragraph V.1.d.i states: *"Analysis of TraCS data demonstrating that fewer than 14% of records of traffic stops, frisks, and searches documented in TraCS during the previous six (6) months are missing any of the information required by paragraph IV.A.3 for inclusion in records."*

CJI initially deemed the Use of Force Justification field, a requirement under V.1.d.i, as not meeting the 14% threshold for the first two quarters of 2020. MPD did not provide data for this field from January through April of 2020 but did provide data for this field for May and June of 2020. In previous reports we indicated data as "not received" rather than missing.

We believe it is more consistent and accurate to assess compliance by looking at only the two months for which we have data on UOF justification. Looking at the share of missing data from those two months only, we find only 5.26% of records are missing Use of Force Justification, well below the threshold.

The attached report differs from the previously submitted report in three places: 1) the Progress Update paragraph on page 20, 2) the third part of row i (use of force justification) of Table 1 on page 21, and 3) table note two of Table 1 on page 21.

We request that Plaintiffs' counsel refile this revised version with the Court and that the Fire and Police Commission use this version for public posting as required by the Agreement. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns about this revision.
