**Property**

Masonry road bridge at the far north end of Lake Park over the ravine.

**Description of work**

Repair the all-masonry road bridge. Tie the barrel vault together with roads, patch missing or damaged areas of brick, concrete terra cotta and stone. Repoint the brick and terra cotta where necessary. Rebuild balustrade on bridge deck using cast concrete. Terra cotta to be repaired with cast concrete copies made from original pieces. Metal crash barrier will be erected at edge of sidewalk to comply with safety regulations

In accordance with the provisions of Section 308-81(9) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. 
All work will be done according to attached photos. The commission requested costs estimates of using genuine terra cotta replacement pieces vs. concrete or concrete patches. All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 




Spalled terra
