Fence will be painted or stained upon completion. Fence will be installed according to attached drawings.





In accordance with the provisions of Section 308-81(9) of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, the Milwaukee Historic Preservation Commission has issued a certificate of appropriateness for the work listed above. The work was found to be consistent with preservation guidelines. The following conditions apply to this certificate of appropriateness:

Sign will be installed and building according to attached drawings. Sign will be made of brushed aluminum face with yellow push through letters. Sign cabinet will be no more than 4" thick. Every effort will be made to minimize or eliminate external conduits and raceways on the building. If conduits are visible, then they must be painted out to match the color of the building.



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YELLOW JACKET Outdoor Illuminated Sign:

- Approx. size: 42" W x 54" H x 4"D.
- Sign cabinet frame construction uses 2" x 2" 1/4" thick weided aluminum with 1/4" thick aluminum plate for frame construction and hanger & bracket assemblies for mounting.
- Sign faces to use CNC router-out 1/6" gs. aluminum. Letters are cut-outs ("windows").
 Includes powder epoxy-coated linish (color to be distermined...).
- Uses 1/4" welded aluminum plate hanger & bracket assemblies for mounting.
- Uses CNC router-out 3/4" thick yellow scrylic "push-through" type letters for "YELLOW JACKET" & "VINTAGE CLOTHING". NOTE: Letters are backlit with neon grid.
- "VINTAGE CLOTHING" to be digitally-cut yellow vinyl (outdoor type).
- * Uses 12-15 mm 4500 White tubing pumped argon forgrid.
- Uses UL approved outdoor type glass tube supports, booting, etc.
- Uses (1) France® outdoor core & coil transformer (self-contained box).
 (PRI, 120V/60Hz SEC, 12,000V / 3 Amps.), UL approved.
- Uses 86 qty. GE® 7-1/2 W /130V 3,000 hr. 1 3/8" dia. med. base incandescent sign bulbs (red).
- All hardware, fasteness and braided cable are hardened and/or stainless steel.
- includes 2 yr. limited warranty for transformers / 1 yr. limited warranty for neon.

NOTE: The design construction, materials, components and installation of all fierrs listed above are to comply with building and electrical code regulations for the city of Milwaukee and state of Wisconsin. Sign will be installed on front elevation of 1235 E. Brady between first and second story window level next to the eastern-most porch.
