Install redwood / cedar fence to enclose yard. The work must be done according to the attached drawings and/or photos, any changes must be approved by HPC staff. Fence must be painted or stained upon completion.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations. 
