

Bronzeville Homeownership Appliance Package Program

Part of the Bronzeville Resident Homeownership Initiative

The Bronzeville Homeownership Appliance Package Program provides a credit for the purchase of appliances to individuals who are buying a City owned home for homeownership in the Bronzeville Initiative area.

The program provides the following:

- A credit of up to \$2,000 to purchase appliances from a participating store*

PROGRAM INFORMATION:

- Homebuyers must be purchasing a City owned home for owner occupancy in the Bronzeville Initiative Area
- Homebuyers must have an accepted offer to purchase from the City of Milwaukee between July 15, 2019 and October 31, 2019

HOW TO APPLY:

Buyers must complete the Bronzeville Homeownership Appliance Package Program Application and Declaration after having their real estate offer to purchase accepted by the City of Milwaukee, but prior to purchasing the home. The Bronzeville Homeownership Appliance Package Program application is available online.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:
