

The City offers multiple transportation and parking options to help ease the commute to work, including an enhanced downtown parking benefit for eligible employees.



Priority Parking Assignments for Onsite Employees

- Work onsite at the City Hall Complex at least three days per week
- Discounted \$65/month parking benefit at the 1000 N. Water St. structure
- Parking access is Monday through Friday: 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Employees who qualify must complete the [parking form](#) including a signature from their Department Head or Personnel Officer and email it to lidia.zgela@abm.com



Parking Flexible Spending Account (FSA)

- Dedicate pre-tax money for out-of-pocket work-related parking expenses
- Contribute up to \$300/month or \$3600/year to Parking FSA

Ride the Bus with a Commuter Value Pass (CVP)

- Commuter Value Pass (CVP) provides unlimited use of all Milwaukee County Transit Services (MCTS) for benefits-eligible general City employees
- Pay \$36/month as pre-tax deduction on first paycheck of every month

Ride a Bike to Work

- Dedicated bicycle parking area for employees in the lower level of Zeidler Municipal Building. Interested? Ask a supervisor to add key card access to City ID Badge
- ANOTHER OPTION: Bublr Bikes is the City's bikeshare program with 100+ Bublr Stations in the Milwaukee area
- Employees must use Milwaukee.gov email and code **MKE2023** for 25% off annual pass or **30MKE2023** for 25% off monthly pass at bublrbikes.org



Ride the Hop!

- The Hop is the City's streetcar service that is FREE to ride
- Service provided downtown every 15 minutes during peak hours, every 20 minutes during off-peak hours and weekends
