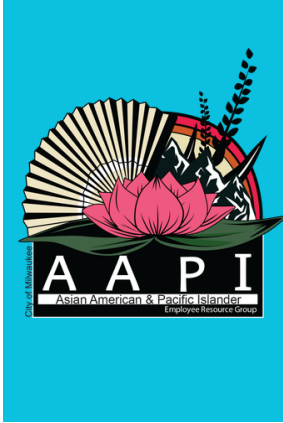
Who: All BAAERG members and allies interested in coming together for sharing updates, learning, and community building.

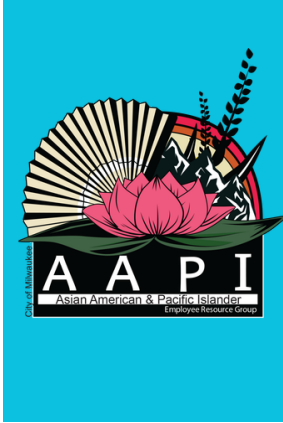
What's The Latest?

- **Arrival time:** 11:15 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.
 - Tour will end between 12:30 p.m. and 1:00 p.m.
- **Attire:** Guests should wear closed-toe shoes and clothing that can get dirty.
 - Part of the program will be in the Community Room, and the other part will be in the indoor arena for time with the horses.
 - If the weather is comfortable, guests will also go outside to meet the rest of the horses toward the end of the program.
- **Directions:** We are almost on the corner of 1st and Lincoln, a block east of District 2. There is road construction just north of us on Becher, so it currently takes a bit of maneuvering to reach us from the north.
 - Take the Lapham exit going East to 1st Street and South to Lincoln. Turn left on Lincoln, and we are immediately on the right side.
- **Parking:** There is a large parking lot right in front of the Stables.

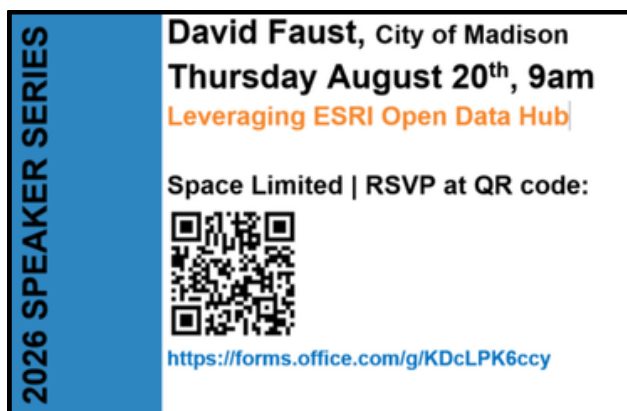

WANT TO BE A MENTOR?

MENTOR Greater Milwaukee

Providing access to quality mentors to Milwaukee's youth by strengthening the organizational capacity and caliber of mentoring organizations.



In 2016, the City of Milwaukee, along with Milwaukee Public Schools (MPS), funded a study to explore the development of a Mentor Affiliate in Milwaukee. They enlisted the Public Policy Forum (PPF) to conduct research titled "Mentoring in Milwaukee: Developing a Regional Mentoring Network."

The study involved more than 13 additional mentoring organizations in a strategic planning process. The findings indicated a significant unmet demand for quality mentors in the community. As a result, several organizations, including Milwaukee Public Schools, the Milwaukee Bucks, and the City of Milwaukee, agreed to partner in addressing this need.

One of the main objectives of Mentor Greater Milwaukee (MGM) is to enhance the capacity of agencies that currently provide mentoring services. Additionally, MGM aims to foster collaboration among these services by establishing an administrative component that will coordinate recruitment and training efforts.
