CADD AND GIS TECHNICIAN 3 (MWW) – 01.10.2025

The CADD and GIS Technician 3 conducts updates and maintenance of Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) mapping and the Geographic Information System (GIS), and prepares and designs engineering construction drawings and plans using Computer-Aided Design and Drafting (CADD) software for the MWW Capital Improvements Program (CIP).

COMMUNITY HEALTH DIETITIAN 1 (MHD) – CONTINUOUS

Under the direction of the WIC Program Manager, the Community Health Dietitian 1 provides nutrition and administrative services for the City of Milwaukee Health Department's (MHD) Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) special supplemental nutrition program and serves as a lead worker for Community Health Nutritionists, WIC Client Services Assistants, and Breastfeeding Peer Counselors.

ELECTION SERVICES COORDINATOR – BILINGUAL (ELECTION COMMISSION) – 01.10.2025

The Election Service Coordinator-Bilingual performs the daily activities required to ensure that elections are adequately staffed. This position is required to be fluent in both English and Spanish to ensure that Milwaukee's Spanish-speaking community has full access to voting in all elections.

ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN IV (DPW) – 01.10.2025

The Engineering Technician IV conducts water main replacement, water distribution system repair, and lead service line replacement inspections to ensure compliance with and enforcement of Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) specifications.

FAMILY VIOLENCE PREVENTION MANAGER (DOA) – 01.10.2025

The Family Violence Prevention Manager oversees and implements strategies and initiatives to prevent family and gender-based violence, to support survivors and to promote safe and healthy families within the City of Milwaukee.

INDUSTRIAL MACHINE REPAIR MECHANIC 1, 2 AND 3 (DPW) – CONTINUOUS

Industrial Machine Repair Mechanics perform preventative maintenance and repairs to Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) equipment and facilities, operate snow and ice control equipment, and perform routine duties at outlying booster stations.

LABOR NEGOTIATOR (DER) – 02.07.2025

The Labor Negotiator serves as a member of the Mayor's Cabinet and is the City of Milwaukee's chief spokesperson and agent in labor relations matters.

The Labor Negotiator develops and administers a comprehensive labor relations program for the City under the general direction and guidance of the Mayor and the Common Council. Under current law, three unions have full bargaining rights: the Milwaukee Police Association (MPA), the Milwaukee Police Supervisors' Organization (MPSO), and the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) Local 215-Milwaukee Professional Fire Fighters. In addition to other employee relations functions, the Labor Negotiator oversees compliance with the meet and confer provisions of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, Section 340-3-2(a).

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LEAD PROJECT INSPECTOR 1 (MHD) – 01.10.2025

The Lead Project Inspector 1 with the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) provides comprehensive property inspections, creates and approves scopes of work, estimates rehabilitation costs, and ensures that rehabilitation and new construction work meets lead abatement standards and state adopted building codes for renovation and construction. Projects must also comply with City of Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, City of Milwaukee construction specifications, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations, and Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) regulations for lead abatement activities.

LIBRARY HUMAN RESOURCES ADMINISTRATOR (MPL) – 01.17.2025

The Library Human Resources Administrator leads the Milwaukee Public Library (MPL) 's human resources (HR) functions, including talent management, compensation and benefits, training and development, compliance, and worker safety.

MUNICIPAL SERVICES ELECTRICIAN (DPW) – 01.10.2025

The Municipal Services Electrician inspects, installs, services, repairs and maintains electrical equipment for the City of Milwaukee's street lighting, traffic control, water and sewer instrumentation, communication network systems, buildings, and facilities.

OFFICE ASSISTANT III-PD (MPD) – 01.10.2025

The Office Assistant III supports the efficiency of the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) units by performing complex and responsible clerical work requiring a command of administrative procedures, automated systems, and departmental policies and procedures.

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE 1 (MHD) – 01.10.2025

Public Health Nurses engage in a variety of population-based and individual nursing activities in homes, schools, clinics and community settings designed to assure that health care is accessible and available to residents. Nursing assignments may be in one of the following programs: Empowering Families of Milwaukee (EFM), Communicable Disease, Tuberculosis Prevention and Care, Home Environmental Health, Milwaukee Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness and Sexual and Reproductive Health.

VIDEO SYSTEMS SPECIALIST (MPD) – 01.10.2025

The Video Systems Specialist maintains and coordinates the installation, repair, maintenance and recovery of various video collection platforms and other specialized equipment used by the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD).

YARD ATTENDANT (DPW) – 01.10.2025

The Yard Attendant ("Drop Off Center Attendant") staffs two Department of Public Works (DPW) Sanitation Services Drop Off Centers. The Yard Attendant greets customers, verifies eligibility for site usage, screens and categorizes vehicle loads, and provides direction to customers at the entrance gate.
