ACCOUNTANT III (DPW) – 04.04.2025

The Accountant III provides financial accounting support for the Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) by preparing financial statements and reports, performing audits, analyzing accounts, forecasting revenues, maintaining the utility's financial model and preparing simplified and conventional utility rate cases.

CADD AND GIS TECHNICIAN 1 AND 2 (DPW) – 03.21.2025

The CADD and GIS Technician drafts construction plans and updates records related to sewer, green infrastructure, and flood mitigation projects using Computer-Aided Design and Drafting (CADD) and Geographic Information Systems (GIS) software.

The Communications Assistant Lead in the Department of Public Works (DPW) Operations Division serves as a lead worker, assisting in the day-to-day operations of the Parking Information Desk.

COMMUNITY HEALTH DIETITIAN 1 (MHD) – CONTINUOUS

Under the direction of the WIC Program Manager, the Community Health Dietitian 1 provides nutrition and administrative services for the City of Milwaukee Health Department's (MHD) Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) special supplemental nutrition program and serves as a lead worker for Community Health Nutritionists, WIC Client Services Assistants, and Breastfeeding Peer Counselors.

COMMUNITY HEALTH NUTRITIONIST 1 (MHD) – CONTINUOUS

Under the direction of the WIC (Women, Infants and Children) Program Manager, the Community Health Nutritionist 1 provides nutritional assessment and counseling and determines program eligibility for the Milwaukee Health Department's (MHD) WIC participants.

EQUIPMENT AND TOOL MECHANIC 3 (DPW) – CONTINUOUS

The Equipment and Tool Mechanic 3 maintains, repairs, and inventories the machinery, shop equipment, power tools, and hand tools both at the Milwaukee Water Works (MWW)-Distribution field headquarters and at field locations.

GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION TECHNICIAN II (DOA) – 04.04.2025

The Geographic Information Technician II provides technical support to the Department of Administration (DOA) in the areas of geographic information system (GIS) mapping, data services, cartographic design, and map production projects, including design, development, analysis, and user support.

INNOVATION POLICY ANALYST (DOA) – 03.21.2025

The Innovation Policy Analyst will work with internal and external stakeholders to enhance revenues and identify and implement opportunities for efficiency and collaboration.

OFFICE ASSISTANT II-PD (MPD) – 03.28.2025

The City of Milwaukee Police Department employs Office Assistant IIs in various divisions. Under supervision, the Office Assistant IIs type letters, reports, records, and other documents and perform a variety of clerical duties.

PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER (DPW) – 03.21.2025

The Parking Enforcement Officer administers all parking and abandoned vehicle regulations, facilitates vehicle turnover to create access, and provides accurate parking-related information and customer service to the public.

POLICE OFFICER (MPD) – 12.05.2025

Police Officers preserve public peace, protect life and property, work within the community to prevent crime, and enforce ordinances of the City of Milwaukee and the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

STREETCAR SYSTEM MANGER (DPW) – 03.21.2025

The Streetcar System Manager oversees the City's streetcar system, The Hop, including all contracts, funding, budgets, reporting, inspections, expansion plans, and service optimization strategies.

WATER PLANT AUTOMATION CONTROLS ENGINEER (DPW) – 04.04.2025

The Water Plant Automation Controls Engineer programs and troubleshoots control systems, operator interfaces, servers and reports for the Milwaukee Water Works SCADA (Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition) system.

WATER PLANT STEAMFITTER (DPW) – CONTINUOUS

The Water Plant Steamfitter installs and repairs industrial systems involving steam and water piping in the Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) water treatment plants, pumping stations and booster stations.

WATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR TRAINEE AND WATER TREATMENT PLANT OPERATOR 1 (DPW) – 03.28.2025

Water Treatment Plant Operator Trainee:

While training under the direction of Water Treatment Plant Operators, the Water Treatment Plant Operator Trainee assists with the operation of a surface water treatment plant, water distribution system, and pumping stations to prepare for promotion to Water Treatment Plant Operator 1.

Water Treatment Plant Operator 1:

The Water Treatment Plant Operator 1 maintains process control of the MWW water treatment plants and distribution pumping systems to meet production requirements for high quality, sufficient drinking water.
