ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES COORDINATOR (PORT MILWAUKEE) – 06.18.2026

The Administrative Services Coordinator serves as the confidential assistant to the Municipal Port Director and as the Assistant Secretary to the Board of Harbor Commissioners (BHC), in addition to providing high-level administrative and project support to other Port Milwaukee sections.

BENEFITS AND WELLNESS SUPERVISOR (DER) – 06.26.2026

The Benefits and Wellness Supervisor oversees daily benefits operations, manages benefits-related systems and processes within the Human Resources Information System (HRIS), supervises benefits staff and coordinates employee outreach, engagement, and education initiatives.

The City of Milwaukee’s benefits programs include health and dental insurance, a comprehensive wellness program, on-site clinics, an on-site nurse liaison, flexible spending and health reimbursement, long-term disability insurance, life insurance, tuition reimbursement, a commuter value pass, and other voluntary benefits focused on healthcare and wellness.

BUDGET AND FISCAL POLICY ANALYST I, II, III, AND IV (DOA) – 06.18.2026

The Budget and Fiscal Policy Analyst performs professional budget, management, and fiscal policy analysis. This role is critical in developing the Mayor’s annual budget, monitoring the impact of expenditures, and proposing annual operating and capital budgets, revenues, and fiscal policy for City of Milwaukee’s departments, funds, and programs.

BUILDING CONSTRUCTION INSPECTOR 3 07.06.2026

The Building Construction Inspector researches applicable codes and standards, inspects properties under construction to ensure compliance with State Codes and City Ordinances, and partners with stakeholders to manage and complete complex projects and developments.

CONTRACT COMPLIANCE OFFICER (DOA) – 06.18.2026

The Contract Compliance Officer oversees and administers all aspects of contract compliance, workforce, and certified small business participation for development projects, as governed by City Ordinance chapters 355 and 370 and corresponding ordinances.

CRIME SCENE SUPERVISOR (MPD) – 06.22.2026

The Crime Scene Supervisor oversees the Forensics Division personnel involved in evidence identification, preservation, collection, and analysis, ensuring recognized techniques within the parameters of the forensic science field are implemented and followed.

ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN IV (MWW) – CONTINUOUS

The Engineering Technician IV conducts water main replacement, water distribution system repair, and lead service line replacement inspections to ensure compliance with and enforcement of Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) specifications.

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR 1 (DPW) – CONTINUOUS

The Equipment Operator 1 performs professional driving and critical manual labor functions, including municipal solid waste and recycling collection, street sweeping, snow and ice control, and operation of heavy equipment for the Department of Public Works. This position is critical to the cleanliness, health and safety of the City, its residents and visitors.

INDUSTRIAL MACHINE REPAIR MECHANIC 3,4, AND REPAIRPERSON 5 (DPW) – CONTINUOUS

Industrial Machine Repair Mechanics and Repairpersons perform preventative maintenance on and repairs to Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) equipment and facilities, operate snow and ice control equipment, and perform routine duties at outlying booster stations.

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LIBRARIAN I (MPL) – 06.22.2026

Librarians help open a world of materials, services, and programs to patrons and serve as liaisons to community partners.

Librarians perform basic bibliographic, reference, readers' advisory, and programming work and participate in a full range of librarian activities, including community service, outreach, and basic collection development. Emphasis is on developing a comprehensive background across all phases of librarianship throughout the system, including children's, young adult, and/or adult services.

The Milwaukee Public Library has vacancies throughout the system, at both the Central Library and our Branch Libraries, with a focus on assignments in the Adult Services section. **The hours for these full-time positions are either Wednesday – Friday: 9:30 am – 6:00 pm and Saturday and Sunday: 8:30 am – 5:00 pm OR Sunday 8:30am – 5pm, and Monday – Tuesday 10:30 – 7pm (Central) or 11:30 – 8pm (Branches), and Wednesday – Thursday 9:30am – 6pm.**

LIBRARY SECURITY GUARD (MPL) – 07.02.2026

The Library Security Guard patrols library facilities, responds to security incidents, and prevents security issues to ensure the safety and security of library staff, the public, facilities, and assets throughout the Milwaukee Public Library (MPL) system.

OPERATIONS MANAGER-DEVELOPMENT CENTER (DNS) – 06.22.2026

Under the direction of the Permit and Development Center Manager, the Operations Manager-Development Center oversees functions and projects associated with the development process, including business planning, process improvement, and performance measurement.

PARKING SERVICES SUPERVISOR (DPW) – 07.02.2026

The Parking Services Supervisor oversees the daily operation of City parking structures and lots, and serves as the City's parking liaison and professional point of contact for contracted management, property management, lessees, contractors, and other City departments.

POLICE OFFICER (MPD) – CONTINUOUS

Police Officers preserve public peace, protect life and property, work within the community to prevent crime, and enforce ordinances of the City of Milwaukee and the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

RECRUITER (FPC) – 06.26.2026

The Recruiter for the Fire and Police Commission (FPC) develops, coordinates and implements a comprehensive and effective recruitment effort for entry-level positions in the Police, Fire and Emergency Communications Departments.

WIC CLIENT SERVICES ASSISTANT 1 (MHD) – 06.22.2026

The WIC Client Service Assistant 1 assigned to the Women, Infants and Children Supplemental Nutrition Program (WIC) provides client and administrative services, including registration, health screening, and food benefit issuance for participants of the WIC Program at various Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) clinics.
