ASSOCIATE PLANNER (DCD) – 07.24.2026

The Associate Planner consults with and provides technical assistance in zoning, land use, housing, and development to the Planning Division staff, other Department of City Development (DCD) personnel, property owners and developers, community-based organizations, and the public.

BUILDING MAINTENANCE SUPERVISOR (MPD) – 07.24.2026

The Building Maintenance Supervisor oversees the HVAC (Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning) Technicians and custodial personnel during the first, second, and third shifts at multiple MPD facilities.

CIVIL ENGINEER (DPW) – 08.07.2026

The Civil Engineer III leads the preparation of design plans, cost estimates, bid items, and unit pricing for green infrastructure and sewer pump related projects, and the review of stormwater management plans submitted for approval for development projects within the City of Milwaukee.

CIVIL ENGINEER IV (DPW) – 07.31.2026

The Civil Engineer IV develops transportation engineering design guidelines, details, and standards to achieve the City's goals of reducing reckless driving and making streets safer and more enjoyable for people to walk, bike, take transit, and drive.

CITY LABORER (DPW) – 08.10.2026

Under supervision, City Laborers perform light to heavy manual work. City Laborers are employed by the Department of Public Works (DPW) in the following areas: Streets, Sewers, Electrical Services, Sanitation and Bridges & Buildings. Assignment to an area is based on the needs of the City.

COMMUNITY HEALTH DIETITIAN 1 (MHD) – CONTINUOUS

Under the direction of the WIC Program Manager, the Community Health Dietitian 1 provides nutrition and administrative services for the City of Milwaukee Health Department's (MHD) Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) special supplemental nutrition program and serves as a lead worker for Community Health Nutritionists, WIC Client Services Assistants, and Breastfeeding Peer Counselors.

COMMUNITY HEALTH NUTRITIONIST 1 (MHD) – CONTINUOUS

Under the direction of the WIC (Women, Infants and Children) Program Manager, the Community Health Nutritionist 1 provides nutritional assessment and counseling and determines program eligibility for the Milwaukee Health Department's (MHD) WIC participants.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH SPECIALIST (DCWS) – 07.24.26

The Community Outreach Specialist supports the City of Milwaukee's violence prevention efforts by overseeing mentorship, outreach, and leadership development initiatives for youth, particularly those at risk, justice-involved, or impacted by community violence and gang involvement.

ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR 3 (DNS) – 07.24.2026

The Electrical Inspector conducts system inspections in commercial, industrial, and residential buildings to ensure compliance with applicable electrical codes.

ELEVATOR INSPECTOR 3 (DNS) – 07.24.2026

The Elevator Inspector 3 conducts inspections of passenger and freight elevators, chair lifts, accessible lifts, escalators, moving walks, and dumbwaiters. These inspections take place in commercial and industrial buildings to ensure that equipment installed in the City of Milwaukee complies with federal, state, and local codes. Inspection work includes testing elevators and reviewing plans or specifications for new or existing elevator installations.

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ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN IV (MWW) – CONTINUOUS

The Engineering Technician IV conducts water main replacement, water distribution system repair, and lead service line replacement inspections to ensure compliance with and enforcement of Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) specifications.

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR 1 (DPW) – CONTINUOUS

The Equipment Operator 1 performs professional driving and critical manual labor functions, including municipal solid waste and recycling collection, street sweeping, snow and ice control, and operation of heavy equipment for the Department of Public Works. This position is critical to the cleanliness, health and safety of the City, its residents and visitors.

ERS PENSION INVESTMENT ANALYST I, II, AND III (ERS) – 08.07.2026

Under the direction of the Employees' Retirement System (ERS) Deputy Chief Investment Officer, the Pension Investment Analyst conducts due diligence on investment managers and monitors performance and compliance for the ERS's \$6.5 billion investment portfolio.

HUMAN RESOURCES SUPERVISOR (MPD) – 07.24.2026

The Human Resources (HR) Supervisor oversees the Milwaukee Police Department's human resources (MPD-HR) team to ensure the efficiency of the HR function for sworn and civilian personnel.

HVAC MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN 1, 2, AND 3 (MPD) – 07.24.2026

HVAC Maintenance Technicians repair, replace, adjust, and maintain equipment related to facilities for the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD).

INDUSTRIAL MACHINE REPAIR MECHANIC 3,4, AND REPAIRPERSON 5 (DPW) – CONTINUOUS

Industrial Machine Repair Mechanics and Repairpersons perform preventative maintenance on and repairs to Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) equipment and facilities, operate snow and ice control equipment, and perform routine duties at outlying booster stations.

INDUSTRIAL MACHINE REPAIRPERSON 5 (DPW) – CONTINUOUS

Industrial Machine Repairpersons 5 perform preventative maintenance on and repairs to Milwaukee Water Works (MWW) equipment and facilities, operate snow and ice control equipment, and perform routine duties at outlying booster stations.

LIBRARY TEEN OUTREACH INTERN (MPL) – 07.31.2026

Teen Interns assist in implementing the library's "Connected Learning for Teens" initiative, fulfilling the mission and vision of the Milwaukee Public Library. Interns serve as faces and voices for the MPL, spearheading teen projects within our 4 library makerspaces and developing new programs for teens in the Milwaukee community. They consult on programs, mentor their peers, and host engaging events, all while developing critical career skills in the process.

NURSE PRACTITIONER (MHD) – 08.07.2026

The Nurse Practitioner functions as an independent healthcare provider who works collaboratively within a multi-disciplinary team of public health professionals to provide comprehensive care to the clients in an outpatient sexual and reproductive health clinical setting.

PLAN EXAMINER SPECIALIST 1 (DNS) – 07.24.2026

The Plan Examiner Specialist 1 provides primary service to walk-in customers seeking building permits, certificates of occupancy, or information on the City of Milwaukee building and zoning codes.

POLICE OFFICER (MPD) – CONTINUOUS

Police Officers preserve public peace, protect life and property, work within the community to prevent crime, and enforce ordinances of the City of Milwaukee and the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

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PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE 2 AND 3 (MHD) – CONTINUOUS

Public Health Nurses engage in a variety of population-based and individual nursing activities in homes, schools, clinics and community settings designed to assure that health care is accessible and available to residents.

TAX ENFORCEMENT SPECIALIST-BILINGUAL (CITY TREASURER) – 08.07.26

The Tax Enforcement Specialist-Bilingual provides administrative support related to tax enforcement, vacated judgments, bankruptcy administration, and customer relations.
