ATHLETIC TRAINER (MFD) – 11.15.2024

The Athletic Trainer assists with the day-to-day administration and operation of the MFD health, safety, fitness, injury care and prevention programming and activities.

COMMUNITY HEALTH ADMINISTRATIVE SPECIALIST 1 (MHD) – 11.22.2024

As part of the Family and Community Health (FCH) Branch, the Community Health Administrative Specialist 1 provides direct support and customer service for various family and community health programs. The FCH Branch facilitates several programs that provide home visiting, health access, nutrition, health education, pre/post-natal and community outreach services which target families impacted by high infant mortality, health, social and economic disparities.

COMMUNITY HEALTH DIETITIAN 1 (MHD) – CONTINUOUS

Under the direction of the WIC Program Manager, the Community Health Dietitian 1 provides nutrition and administrative services for the City of Milwaukee Health Department's (MHD) Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) special supplemental nutrition program and serves as a lead worker for Community Health Nutritionists, WIC Client Services Assistants, and Breastfeeding Peer Counselors.

COMMUNITY HEALTH NUTRITIONIST 1 (MHD) – 11.22.2024

Under the direction of the WIC (Women, Infants and Children) Program Manager, the Community Health Nutritionist 1 provides nutritional assessment and counseling and determines program eligibility for the Milwaukee Health Department's (MHD) WIC participants.

CRIME ANALYST I (MPD) – 11.15.2024

The Crime Analyst collects, collates, analyzes, disseminates, and evaluates data to discover developing trends, patterns, and changes in criminal activity.

The Crime Analyst may be assigned to the Office of Management, Analysis and Planning (OMAP), the Fusion Division, or the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) Districts.

ENGINEERING INTERN (DPW-INFRASTRUCTURE) – 12.06.2024

Engineering Interns assist engineers, architects, engineering technicians, public works inspectors, and bridges and buildings inspectors with various engineering and construction inspection tasks.

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR 1 (DPW) – 11.22.2024

The Equipment Operator 1 performs professional driving and critical manual laboring functions, including municipal solid waste and recycling collection, street sweeping, snow and ice control, and operation of heavy equipment for the Department of Public Works. This position is critical to the cleanliness, health and safety of the City, its residents and visitors.

FACILITIES CONTROL SPECIALIST (MPL) – 11.08.2024

The Facilities Control Specialist inspects, tests, repairs, and maintains the Milwaukee Public Library (MPL) System's Building Control Systems.

GRANTS FISCAL MANAGER (COMPTROLLER) – 11.20.2024

The Grants Fiscal Manager provides leadership and fiscal oversight of the City's grant programs by safeguarding city assets, ensuring grant management systems and internal accounting controls are maintained per laws, regulations, granting agency requirements, and city policy guidelines.

HEALTH INVENTORY CONTROL SPECIALIST (MHD)- 11.15.2024

The Health Inventory Control Specialist oversees purchasing, managing, and controlling all inventory stock in the City of Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) Central Supply area.

MUNICIPAL SERVICES ELECTRICIAN (DPW) – CONTINUOUS

The Municipal Services Electrician inspects, installs, services, repairs and maintains electrical equipment for the City of Milwaukee's street lighting, traffic control, water and sewer instrumentation, communication network systems, buildings, and facilities.

POLICE OFFICER (MPD) – 12.06.2024

Police Officers preserve public peace, protect life and property, work within the community to prevent crime, and enforce ordinances of the City of Milwaukee and the laws of the State of Wisconsin.

PROGRAM ASSISTANT III (MHD) – 11.08.2024

The Program Assistant III provides administrative support for the program managers, coordinators, and staff in the Milwaukee Breast and Cervical Cancer Awareness/Well Woman Program.

PUBLIC HEALTH NURSE 1, 2 AND 3 (MHD) – 11.22.2024

Public Health Nurses engage in a variety of population-based and individual nursing activities in homes, schools, clinics and community settings designed to assure that health care is accessible and available to residents. The nursing assignments for this recruitment will be in the Sexual and Reproductive Health (SRH) program.

URBAN FORESTRY INTERN (DPW) – 12.17.2024

Urban Forestry Interns participate in a variety of forestry work activities, including the chemical treatment of ash trees at risk for Emerald Ash Borer (EAB); manual labor associated with the planting and maintenance of trees, plants, and turf throughout the City of Milwaukee; and data collection and analysis, research, and other special projects.

YOUTH FLEET APPRENTICE (MFD) – 11.22.2024

Under the direction of the Fire Fleet Repair Manager and job site mentors, the Youth Fleet Apprentice works full-time during the summer and/or part-time during the school year.

Youth Fleet Apprentices assigned to Construction and Maintenance will be trained to complete automotive and diesel vehicle maintenance.
