<b>JUSTIFICATION FOR WAIVER REQUEST:</b> Work Clothing is required for an emergency recruit class of 35 to be held between August 13, 2007 through December 13, 2007 that was approved by the Finance and Personnel Committee due to fire fighter vacancies and upcoming retirements at year end. Without the addition of a recruit class in 2007, there would not be enough fire fighters to staff the various station houses.  Clothing Affidavits were received from the awarded vendor-Goldfish Uniforms and the manufacturer (Midway Cap) furnishing the caps to the Fire Dept.  The manufacturers to furnish the trousers (Williamson-Dickie Mfg Co), shirts (Fechheimer –Flying Cross brand), and jacket (Elbeco) submitted their Workplace Code of Conduct standards or a statement that they have a code of Conduct and Ethics in lieu of completing the City's clothing affidavit form.			
I HEREBY CERTIFY that in my opinion, a waiver of compliance with the requirements of the ordinance is necessary in the interest of the City of Milwaukee.
