

HOME EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS KIT

When an emergency happens, it is important to be prepared. Create a portable **HOME EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS KIT** to take with you if you suddenly have to leave your home or need to shelter in place (e.g., power outage, severe storm).

Your **HOME EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS KIT** should consider the following items:

- Bottled water
- Food in easy-to-open containers
- Prescription medications, list and paper copies of prescriptions (1-week supply)
- Copies of important documents in waterproof container: identification, passport, home / auto insurance, bank account numbers
- Small first-aid kit
- Personal hygiene items
- Warm clothes, rain gear, sturdy shoes
- Credit / debit cards, small amount of money, and / or prepaid ATM card
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Power bank (rechargeable battery)
- Blankets
- Candles and lighter / matches
- Pocket knife / box cutter / scissors / multi-tool
- Garbage bags and duct tape
- Battery-operated / manual radio
- House and car keys
- Family Emergency Plan (*on back!*)
- Regional road map
- Recent family photos for identification, including pets
- Special needs items: glasses, hearing aids, canes, walkers, diapers and formula
- Pet care items: food, proof of rabies, vaccination, crate / carrier

Additional Considerations:

- Keep your kit in a bag that is sturdy and easy to carry
- Store your kit in a secure place that is easy to get to
- Prepare for year round use (all seasons)
- Replace expired / outdated items in your kit **every 6 months** (*review your kit when you change your clocks!*)




